FAVORITE CAT FOOD BRANDS

Cats are obligate carnivores and require high protein and low carbohydrate nutrition. They thrive on high protein diets with high moisture content and minimal carbohydrates. Unfortunately, kibble is dry and packed with carbohydrates. If your kitty is currently on an all kibble diet, don't panic! Here are my recommendations along with my favorite brands.

FREEZE DRIED RAW DIETS

These diets are more processed than a frozen raw but can mimic the kibble texture that so many kitties enjoy and are great for convenience and travel.

Stella & Chewys Freeze Dried Food Dinner Morsels

PROS: The 8 flavor/protein choices give your cat a delicious variety and is a favorite in my household. Stella & Chewys has been in the pet food industry for over 20 years and is a solid and reputable brand.

CONS: Some small kittens may find the pieces too large.

Open Farm Freeze Dried Raw Recipes for Cats

PROS: These small morsels do a great job of mimicking kibble. Open Farm's transparent ingredient sourcing is easy to follow and access.

CONS: There are currently only four formulations to choose from.



FROZEN RAW DIETS

These diets are ideal as they provide high protein and moisture content. I recommend thawing in your cat's bowl as cats have different temperature preferences.

Stella's & Chewys Frozen Raw Cat Food Dinner Morsels

PROS: These morsels make dispensing while frozen a breeze!

CONS: There are only four formulas. My cats wish there were more flavors available!

Viva Raw

PROS: This is a small company that balances diets using only real, whole foods. This is one of the only products on the market that balances to AAFCO standards without synthetic vitamins/minerals. Use the code DRANGIE for 25% off your first order.

CONS: These come packaged in 1 pound bricks that require the entire brick to be thawed at one time and stored in the refrigerator.

CANNED DIETS

Wet food comes in many packaging types and is high in moisture and is accepted by the majority of cats. These diets are convenient and allow for an easy way to administer supplements.



Wellness

PRO: There is a large variety of flavors and textures that most cats love! This brand is sold at many retailers including Whole Foods and Petco/PetSmart.

CON: The large variety of formulations can be overwhelming for humans. Just let your cat decide!

Weruva

PRO: This is a patient favorite with formulas made with limited ingredients. It's sold at specialty pet food stores and Petco/PetSmart. They also have a lower phosphorus food ideal for early stages of kidney disease.

CON: There are no significant cons for this brand!
